Leveraging Data for Decision
Making

•Goal: Data is collected to enable quantitative analysis in all facets of the organization – fundraising, rescue, fostering, adoptions, communications.

•Outcome measure: Data entry for BARRK is up to date and within 95% accuracy by December 31, 2023.

•Goal: Data is utilized to understand current benchmarks, set measurable goals, and track success.

•Outcome measure: All monthly/quarterly/annual reports submitted to the Board have complete metrics by December 31, 2023.

Stabilizing Operations

•Goal: RCR manages the target number of cat rescues with sustainable volunteer effort.

- Outcome measures:
 - •85% of cats are adopted from foster care within 90 days of being adoptable by June 2023, 95% within 90 days by Dec 2023
 - •Percentage of cats adopted out of total rescues each month increases by 30% from baseline by the end of 2024
 - •All volunteer positions are filled within 1 month of vacancy by the end of 2023
- •Stable revenue generating enough revenue to cover committed costs plus target number of cats and not go into a deficit
- •Outcome measure: TBD

Improving Work Environments

•Goal: RCR volunteers feel they are valued and provide meaningful contributions to the organization with manageable time commitments.

 - •Number of new cats found near cat colonies decreases from baseline by end of 2024 (target TBD)
