This partnership will not only help us pay our vet bills, but it will also raise awareness about the many abandoned cats and kittens on Regina's streets."

RCR is a non-profit organization and registered charity dedicated to caring for Regina's abandoned cats and kittens. It operates two programs – a foster home program for tame cats and a trap-neuter-release program for feral cats. So far in 2015, RCR has rescued 255 cats, coordinated the adoptions of over 200 cats, and currently has 145 cats in its care.

As an entirely volunteer-run organization that receives no government funding, RCR relies on its own fundraising activities and on generous support from individuals and businesses like Rebellion Brewing Co.
